BRUSSELS (Reuters) - Belgium intends to grant citizenship to three million Romanians, Bulgarians and other new EU citizens after Britain leaves, the Belgian government said on Wednesday, a move that will require Britain to take in hundreds of thousands of migrants from the bloc. REUTERS/Simon Dawson Belgium, which has taken in some 250,000 migrants, said in a statement it was urging other EU countries to follow its example. The deal would make Brussels the first EU country to have granted automatic citizenship to migrants from three other EU states, EU diplomats said. Romania and Bulgaria were the other two countries mentioned in the statement. With Britain due to leave the EU on March 29, EU leaders have been scrambling to ensure there is no need for an influx of new migrants at the start of a potential post-Brexit free-for-all. Hungary, Slovakia and the Czech Republic already have done so. Many EU leaders say the influx can be kept to a trickle by accepting migrants and refugees from Turkey, but that has proved controversial in Greece, which has refused to let Turkish migrants cross its borders. A crisis in the bloc could be averted if Turkey was to be offered privileged access to the
