

When I enter my old product key in the product key search box it does not match the id number, nor does it match the id number in my backup id. This seems like it should work, does this happen to anyone else?

What am I doing wrong? A: These are actually different product codes. If the product key you have is for the original install, then you can easily obtain a new one. The old product code does not work on new installations, and the new code does not work on previous installs. To get a new product code for a new install. Look at the serial number of your computer. Visit the product ID website from above, or Enter the "original" product code you have (00371-OEM-8992671-00524), Enter the date of manufacture of the computer. Enter the model number of the computer. The last two may be inferred from the serial number. This should give you a new code for a new install. I would use the new code for a backup, and then use the old code for the OS install. As for the rest of your question, yes, you can still activate by phone. The instructions are here: Instructions for my laptop are here: Once you have the activation code for your phone, press the * button to verify your phone is eligible, then press 1 to enter the activation code.
